Violas (Vla. I-III): Part I and II play a rhythmic accompaniment with dynamics *ff*, *mf*, *f*. Part III starts at *mf* and includes *arco clb. ric*, *pizz*, and *arco s. pont.* markings.

Violoncellos (Vc. I-II): Part I and II play a rhythmic accompaniment with dynamics *ff*, *mf*, *f*. Part II includes *arco clb. ric* and *pizz* markings.

Double Bass (Db): Part I includes *gliss.* markings and dynamics *ff*, *mf*, *f*, *mp*.
